
Set Up Your Login

Follow the steps below to set up your login for the virtual conference.

Enter the email you used to register for the conference. Click "Next." Because this will be your first time logging in as an attendee, select "Reset your password."




Again, enter the email you used to register for the conference.



The system will send you an email to create a password to access the conference. The email will be from 2020 CPQI, support@vhx.tv.

Check your email for a message with instructions on how to create your password.



Be sure and check your spam or junk folder, for the email if you don't receive the email in your inbox. If you are not able to locate the email, follow the instructions above again, but this time click "Email me a sign in link." Getting access with this link will require you to set up your account password on the site by clicking the user icon in the upper right corner.
