



# MyEvaluations Core Outcome Reporting

**For Program Administrators and Faculty, including Program Directors, Mentors, and CCC Members**

In MyEvaluations, the **Active Assessment Using Direct Observation** evaluation form is already mapped to the following milestone groups:

1. **ACGME Family Medicine 2.0**
2. **ABFM Core Outcomes of Family Medicine Education**

As evaluations are completed, the data will automatically flow into these mapped milestone groups and become available for review.

## 1. Curricular Assessment Worksheet

Access the milestone-based review from: **Evaluations > Curricular Assessment Worksheet (CAW)**

From the CAW, Program Administrators, Program Directors, CCC members, and other authorized faculty can select the appropriate milestone group for semi-annual review. Available milestone groups include:

- **ACGME Family Medicine 2.0**
- **ABFM Core Outcomes**

The CAW allows users to review resident performance across the selected milestone framework. This supports CCC preparation, semi-annual review, and milestone reporting workflows.

The data displayed in the CAW is generated from completed evaluations, including the mapped direct observation assessment questions. Scores and feedback are organized under the appropriate milestone areas based on the evaluation mapping.

## 2. Resident Performance View

Resident-level performance information is also available from: **Home > Performance**

From this area, users can select a specific trainee to view their performance data. This view provides access to evaluation-based performance information for the selected resident, including data that contributes to mapped milestone groups such as:

- **ACGME Family Medicine 2.0**
- **ABFM Core Outcomes**

This allows Program Directors, mentors, CCC members, and authorized faculty to review resident performance in one centralized location.

### **3. Evaluation Comments and Narrative Feedback**

Comment-type questions and narrative feedback are accessible through completed evaluations and resident performance review areas.

Users can review individual evaluation responses, including comments and observations submitted by faculty. This includes optional comments entered for individual direct observation questions, as well as the final overall comment field.

These comments may be used to support:

- CCC discussion
- Semi-annual resident feedback
- Identification of strengths
- Identification of areas for improvement
- Resident development planning
- Review of specific clinical encounters

### **4. Core Outcome and Milestone Review**

Because the direct observation evaluation form is mapped to both the **ACGME Family Medicine 2.0** milestones and the **ABFM Core Outcomes** “milestone group”, completed assessment data will naturally display within those areas.

Program Administrators and faculty can use these views to review resident performance across milestone domains and core outcome areas, supporting both formative feedback and formal semi-annual review.
